Wisconsin Inland Trout Stamp by the Numbers Anglers Investment in Habitat is Paying Dividends

Wisconsin Trout Unlimited supports an increase in the Inland Trout Stamp Fee to help make trout fishing even better in Wisconsin.

> Wisconsin has over 13,000 miles of classified trout steams and about 1,000 spring ponds. The Inland Trout Stamp was \$7.25 in 1992 and raised to it's current price of \$10 in 2006.

On average, Trout Stamp funds improve and maintain 25 miles of trout streams and 1 spring pond every year. (source: WI Inland Trout Management Plan, 2019-2029).

If we keep pace for the next 20 years, that's 500 miles of improvements and 20 spring ponds.

If we increase the Trout Stamp to \$15, that's 750 miles of improvements and 30 spring ponds. (Estimates DO NOT account for rising costs of materials and labor)

Outpaced by Inflation:

\$7.25 Fee in 1992 adjusted for inflation would be \$16.20 in 2023.\$10 Fee in 2006 adjusted for inflation would be \$15.10 in 2023.
